



Information for foreign exhibitors

1. VAT reglementation for foreign exhibitors

As from January 1, 2011, foreign exhibitors are charged no VAT if they are accountable for VAT in their own country. Participants who are established and VAT registered in a foreign country should take care of VAT payment to the competent administration in their country themselves. It is thus essential for them to include their VAT identification number on all relevant forms so as to obtain invoicing without Belgian VAT by the organiser.

2. Customs formalities

TRADE OF GOODS BETWEEN EU MEMBER STATES

No customs formalities required

- Except in case of transit through Switzerland
- Except for the consumption/sale of wines and spirits, subject to excise duties.

GOODS FROM NON-EU MEMBER STATES

Customs formalities required.

Delivery to Ziegler Expo Logistics under customs transit (T1) or ATA Carnet or TIR Carnet. Procedure for temporary import, consumption or re-export formalities.

Before goods can be delivered to or retrieved from the stand, the customers formalities must be carried out by Ziegler at Brussels Expo first. All goods for which ZIEGLER has seen to the customs formalities upon arrival, must be delivered again to the ZIEGLER customs office without fail before they leave the Exhibition Centre.

The exhibitor/official stand holder is responsible for all the exhibitors and subcontractors present on his stand, for the strict compliance with customs regulations and for the payment of customs formalities, fines, import duties, excises and VAT due in full to ZIEGLER.
